Make-Up Work:

Students who are absent or who arrive late without an official university or a medical doctor's excuse may miss in-class activities. There will be no make ups for proficiencies unless an excused absence has been warranted. Students who must miss a proficiency because of an excused absence must complete the work at a time outside of class as scheduled by the instructor. All make-up work must be completed by the last day of class unless other approved arrangements are made. It is the student's obligation to pursue any make-up work.

Attendance Policy:

Class attendance is expected. Since proficiencies will be presented and evaluated in class as part of your grade, any absences may result in a grade point reduction.
